Housing with Care is designed to meet the needs of older people who need help with daily living but who want to remain as independent as possible.



Accommodation is provided through self-contained flatlets. This flatlet is your own private and personal accommodation.

Each flatlet has its own en-suite; with toilet, wash-hand basin and shower, and a kitchen unit; with refrigerator and sink and tea/coffee making facilities. Residents create a familiar environment by furnishing their own flatlet.

You will have your own door key and your privacy will be respected at all times by members of staff. A lift provides access to all floors.



There are facilities to enable you to live as independently in your own room as you are able and you may come and go as you please. There are communal lounges and dining rooms where both social and leisure activities take place and where meals are served. Residents are encouraged to get involved in the running of the home.



Services Provided

A full meal service is available, special diets can be catered for and the cook will discuss your individual requirements with you.

Care Staff are on duty 24 hours daily and, where necessary, will help with bathing, laundry, dressing, cleaning, meals. medications and social activities. Long-term nursing care is not available, but we may be able to make special arrangements for people who require short-term Community Nursing Services after becoming resident. will Friends and relatives be encouraged to help where they are able to do so.
