Located on Frome Road in the suburb of Writhlington, Hanover Court offers 37 one bedroom apartments. The estate is set within attractive shared gardens with seating areas. Regular bus services connect Radstock to the spa town of Bath, Wells, Midsomer Norton and Frome.

Local facilities

Radstock is a former mining and railway town located on the old Roman 'Fosse Way'. Once the powerhouse for Bath, Radstock has some unique architecture associated with its mining and Victorian heritage. It has been described as the best preserved former mining town in the country.

Independent retailers in the town offer a range of food, retail and service outlets, and are mostly based in The Street, Fortescue Road and Wells Hill.

Out and about

The former market hall now houses the Radstock Museum which has a range of exhibits which offer an insight into north-east Somerset life since the 19th century. Many of the exhibits relate to local geology and the now disused Somerset coalfields. The town is also home to the famous Writhlington School Orchid collection. The students are now experts in the field of orchid growing and hold many exhibitions throughout the year.

There is a cycle route that runs through Radstock on the old railway line from the Dundas Aqueduct to Frome. The town is close to the historic cities of Bath, Wells and Glastonbury.

Transport links

Radstock is a town in Somerset, England, 9 miles south west of Bath, and 8 miles north west of Frome. Regular bus services connect Radstock to the spa town of Bath, Wells, Midsomer Norton and Frome.
