Description and Location

Gordon Crescent is a quiet residential Road in Addiscombe close to local shops, doctor's surgery, dentist surgery and Post Office. It is owned and managed by Croydon Council

Building Layout


Gordon Crescent is a block of 44 one bedroom flats, all of which are self contained. Each flat has its own bathroom, kitchen and heating. Adaptations to support mobility problems can be made by individual arrangement. A lift service is available to every floor. An entry phone system operates with a phone in every flat. The building and garden are wheelchair accessible from the street and carpark.

Communal Facilities

There is a communal lounge with a large kitchen area where residents can enjoy coffee mornings and celebrations such as Christmas parties. A quiet room / library has been set up outside the wardens office, and a laundry room is available for use by all residents.

Local Transport and Area

197 and 312 bus stops very near. The Tramlink stop is a short walk away, all with links to Croydon town centre and mainline train stations.
