About the scheme

Neptune court is located in the town of Borehamwood. The scheme offers 29 homes specifically designed for older people, and offers an opportunity for independent living in a safe, comfortable and secure environment.

The scheme is set over three floors, with lifts and stairs to the second and third floors. The flats are one and two bedroom and have separate lounge, kitchen and bathroom. All offer bright, spacious living accommodation. The scheme is fully accessible to wheelchair users.

Neptune Court is central to Borehamwood town centre where you can find Borehamwood shopping park, as well as a GP surgery, chemist and post office®. There are also two market days a week around the corner from the scheme. The bus stop nearby will take you to Luton, St Albans, Watford and Edgeware. There is also the main line station that can take you towns and cities further afield, as well as central London.

Facilities

- 29 homes
- 24 hour emergency response service via an intercom and pull cords within each property
- Security door entry to the main door that can be operated from each flat
- Night storage heating
- Communal lounge with small kitchen, where residents can go have a chat with other tenants, as well as coffee mornings, Bingo and fish and chip lunches
- Garden
- Visiting hairdresser, opticians and chiropodist

Who can apply?

Neptune Court is a scheme that has been designed for older people or those with disabilities.
