Homes for independent living with care for life

This unique Carlisle 'Extra Care community' is the first of its kind in Cumbria, enabling residents to live independently in their own homes. It provides a mix of 60 apartments, houses and bungalows for outright sale, part ownership and for rent.

The development

Set in beautifully landscaped gardens this 'Extra Care community' has been created to meet the needs of people aged 55 and over.

Designed as "Lifetime Homes", the properties can be easily adapted to reflect current and changing needs of the occupier, complemented with tailor-made care packages that can be flexible to maintain independent living in your own home.

Heysham Gardens

The heart of the development. Secure entry scheme of 40 two bedroom apartments on two levels linked by a central core. The ground floor apartments have a patio seating area and first floor homes have large feature windows. They all have easy access to communal areas indoors and the communal gardens.

Heysham Meadows

A cluster of 16 bungalows designed as 'Lifetime Homes' and four houses with disability suites. These properties are adjacent to Heysham Gardens and have access to the communal facilities and care packages.

Residents of Heysham Gardens and Heysham Meadows also benefit from on-site facilities:

- Treatment/therapy/hair salon
- Indoor communal areas
- Café/catering





Design is in the detail

Designed with high standard of light and space, these homes have been created to be flexible - as 'Lifetime Homes' that can be adapted as your needs change. They have the flexibility to be remodelled, creating either larger living area or a large bedroom. All homes have disabled access and have been installed with Careline for peace of mind. They offer fitted kitchens, telephone and computer points - with provision for digital TV, satellite and broadband.

Apartments

The two bedroom apartments are located in the central core of the development which benefits from secure entry. The core also has specially adapted bathroom facilities and a guest bedroom. Apartments are linked to the communal lounge and treatment room.

Bungalows

A range of two and three bedroom properties with private gardens. All have off road parking and some benefit from car ports.

Houses

The houses are traditional three bedroom semi-detached properties. They have the added benefit of a ground floor bedroom incorporating a walk in shower en-suite. These homes benefit from off road parking.

Management and Support Services

The scheme has an on-site Care Team and a Support Team co-ordinating regular activities. Careline is also installed in all homes, offering peace of mind and security in your own home. Emergency response 24/7.

The environment

The scheme makes use of environmental and ecologically friendly materials like the Sedum roof on Heysham Gardens - a living, low maintenance roof that changes with the seasons.

The development is highly insulated with extremely efficient heating systems, solar panels and a ground source heat pump. Natural, responsibly sourced timbers and other materials have also been used throughout. This scheme will be awarded Code for Sustainable Homes – Level 3 from the Building Research Establishment.

The gardens

The gardens have been designed to help support and encourage local wildlife and native plants. They incorporate water and sensory features allowing residents to see, touch, smell and listen, while enjoying the gardens.




A sense of community
