About the scheme

William Sutton House is located in the village of Shenley Church End, which is on the outskirts of Milton Keynes. The scheme has 43 self contained flats, specifically designed for older people, and offers an opportunity for independent living in a safe, comfortable and secure environment.

The scheme is set over 2 floors, with lifts and stairs leading to the first floor accommodation. All the flats have one bedroom with separate lounge, kitchen and bathroom.

Within walking distance of the scheme there is a retail centre offering a variety of shops, a leisure centre and swimming pool. There is also a GP surgery, pharmacy, post office® and a dental surgery.

Outside the scheme you will find the bus stop that can take you into Milton Keynes and to near by towns. There is also a train station close to the town centre, which offers regular services to central London.

Facilities

- 43 self contained properties
- 24 hour emergency response service via an intercom and pull cords within each property
- Security door entry system to the main front door, which can be operated from each flat.
- Night storage heating.
- Communal lounge with kitchen facilities, where a variety of events and activities are available.
- Communal tumble dryer room for residents use only
- Guest room for residents' family and friends to use.
- Comfortable communal garden.

Who can apply?

William Sutton House, is a retirement housing scheme for people aged 55 and over who will benefit from some additional support and security.
