Antonine Rise, named after nearby Roman Antonine Wall, is situated in the north of the town, close to Kirkintilloch Golf Course. Kirkintilloch lies on the famous Forth and Clyde Canal just eight miles north east of Glasgow city centre. The centre of Kirkintilloch, which is well equipped and boasts a host of high street names, can be easily reached by a local bus service close to the development. For those who like to travel further afield, Kirkintilloch train station provides excellent links to Glasgow and beyond.

General needs housing is not specifically designed to suit specialised physical needs. It is suitable for single people or couples.
