- ◆ Bridgecote Lane is a leasehold complex on the fringe of Basildon consisting of bungalows, ground and first floor flats. The scheme can be found off of the A176 Noak Hill Road, turning into Wash Road, and then Bridge Street leads into Bridgecote Lane
- ◆ The Local Area (Laindon) Housing Office is located at Clock House, 49 Laindon Centre, Laindon, (01268) 465161
- ◆ The Shelterad Scheme Co-ordinator can be contacted on (01268) 280123
- ◆ The nearest shops are in Coppice Lane, a short walk, and include a super market, newsagent, chemist and Post Office
- ◆ The nearest Doctors Surgery is in Bridge Street and the closest Dentist is just over one mile away at Great Knightleys
- ◆ First National buses serve the complex from bus stops in Bridge St; service 100 takes in Basildon Town Centre, Lakeside, Billericay Town Centre and Chelmsford. The 101 bus route goes to the hospital

The Common Room

- ◆ Bridgecote Lane has a small Common Room where activities such as Coffee Mornings and Social Evenings take place. The Common Room also houses a Video and book library

- ◆ Individual flats at the Bridgecote Lane complex have their own front door but are linked to the Scheme Coordinator and/ or Careline by an Alarm System ensuring privacy, security and peace of mind

- ◆ **Service Charges** agreed in consultation with residents and cover all Basildon District Council's expenditure on the scheme. Amongst which, are the costs of the Scheme Co-ordinator, communal areas' heating, lighting, cleaning and maintenance, and are paid in addition to your ground rent
