Lochar Crescent is nestled against the backdrop of the White Cart River on the edge of Pollok. It is close to the Burrell Collection and Silverburn Shopping Centre as well as Glasgow city centre. Lochar Crescent has easy access to excellent public transport links to Glasgow and further afield.

About your home

The development is well established within the local community and offers 27 flats. Each property has its own kitchen, livingroom, bedroom and bathroom. Lochar Crescentis set out over two levels, served by both a lift and stairs ensuring easy access throughout the development. It also offers an attractive residents' lounge which overlooks the river and is frequently used by residents. Laundry facilities are available for residents to use.

Security

The standard Trust safety and security features are installed throughout the development. These include fire alarms and a sophisticated call system in each flat, which provides communication with an alarm centre 24 hours a day. The front door of the development is covered by a secure door entry system.

There is a busy entertainment schedule in place including bingo and film evenings; giving our residents the opportunity to come together to foster a positive community spirit.

What is supported housing?

Supported housing provides a range of services and facilities designed to meet the needs of older people aged 60 years and above. Personal care and support is not provided by Trust but can be provided by the local council's social work staff or outside agencies.

One hour of cleaning is also provided each week. This consists of several visits each week, to keep surfaces in the kitchen and bathroom hygienic. The flats have their windows cleaned regularly, both inside and out.
