

BOWHAYES LODGE

Extra Care Sheltered Scheme

Bowhayes Lodge Extra Care Scheme is located in Crewkerne, Somerset, in a quiet location, just a two-minute walk from the town centre.

The scheme has 36 units of accommodation, consisting of

31 self-contained one-bedroom flats and 5 one-bedroom bungalows. There is a spacious communal lounge, communal kitchen, laundry room, shower room and a staff sleep in room within the scheme.

Each flat has a community alarm system for emergencies, night storage heaters and smoke detectors and UPVC double glazed windows.

Bowhayes Lodge also has the added security of a door entry system. There is also an intermediate care flat used for those with rehabilitation needs after illness before returning to their own home.



Extra Care allows for the frail elderly to continue to live independently with the help of care staff as appropriate.

Extra care is not a provider of nursing care but provides help with everyday living.

Bowhayes Lodge is a very friendly scheme, where you can join in with as many of the social activities that you want. Our care team will make you very welcome, respect your personal wishes and will always treat you as an individual. We have many activities on offer at the scheme including coffee mornings, bingo and video nights, live entertainment, pub lunches plus barbeques in the summer.

A choice of three hairdressers' and chiropodists visit the scheme regularly. Two mobile libraries also visit the scheme on a regular basis, but books and cassette tapes are always available for residents to borrow

at the scheme, and reorders of regular medication are delivered weekly to the scheme by a local pharmacy. In addition, there is often local entertainment, where door to door transport can be provided if residents decide that they would like to join in. Crewkerne is a small market town located 24 miles from Taunton and 9 miles from Yeovil. There is a good bus service in Crewkerne to the surrounding villages and towns in the area. The nearest bus stop is located along Furland Road or in the town centre by the George Hotel.

The town has a good selection of shops, which include supermarkets, chemist, butchers, newsagent and bakery. It also has many amenities such as banks, post office, dentist, opticians and doctors' surgeries. There is a wide range of places to eat and drink, which include pubs, Chinese takeaway, Indian takeaway, coffee shop and a fish and chip shop.
