Haven Court Sheltered Scheme

Haven Court provides quality self-contained accommodation for people over 55 years of age

Where are we?

Haven Court is a Sheltered Scheme for over 55s. Erdington is a 10 minute walk, with all the amenities of a good shopping area. The scheme is close to local bus routes for Birmingham City Centre and Sutton Coldfield. Gravelly Hill train station is only a 10 minute walk away.

Self-contained Flats

Haven Court has 38 flats, two of which are designed for the disabled.

Each flat comprises a lounge, kitchen, bathroom and bedroom. Cookers and fridge/freezers are installed in all properties and are maintained by Mercian.

Facilities & Services

- There is lift access to all floors
- A Guest Room is available for a nominal fee for use when friends and family wish to stay



 All flats have orange pull cords and 24-hour cover in the event of an emergency. A Sheltered Scheme Officer resides on site and is on duty each week day

- The Officer will call each tenant daily, during the week to monitor all is well
- Haven Court has two communal lounges for tenants to meet and join in with any social events that are planned at the scheme
- Social events vary from coffee mornings, bingo, buffets and day trips
- There is a Laundry with washing machines and tumble driers
- Contractors maintain the communal gardens and clean the outside of all windows
- Tenants can register for the Ring and Ride service
- The communal areas of the scheme are nonsmoking areas.

Support

The service aims to offer tenants the opportunity to live independently within a secure environment.

Staff deliver caring, assistance and supportive advice on a range of subjects.

A Support Plan will be offered to you after you have settled in.

The Plan will highlight your needs to make your life easier.
