

This project is a result of a close working partnership between Orwell Housing Association and Mid Suffolk District Council.



The aims of the scheme

- To provide warm, comfortable, rented accommodation where people of retirement age can feel safe and secure
- To enable individuals to receive the level of support needed to allow them to live independently, while enjoying the privacy of their own homes
- To provide an environment both for those who enjoy an active social life and those who prefer the tranquillity of their own home
- To enable couples to remain living together.

The scheme

Drift Court is located in the pleasant Georgian town of Needham Market with homes of architectural interest.

This town boasts a well-stocked library, community centre and convenience store, all of which are within walking distance from the scheme.

Needham Market has an excellent bus service to the neighbouring towns of Ipswich, Stowmarket and Bury St Edmunds. For the convenience of the tenants a free bus also runs once a week to and from Tesco's.

The railway station is very close to the scheme as it is only a few minutes' walk away.

Drift Court is situated in attractive gardens, close to the centre of town and all its amenities, which include many shops, a bank, dental practice and doctor's surgery. Surprisingly though, its location beside a bridle path makes Drift Court a very tranquil and desirable place to live.

The communal lounge hosts weekly coffee mornings as well as a variety of other social activities.

Accommodation

- 35 self-contained1 and 2 bedroom flats
- Lift to upper floor.

Central facilities

- A tenants' lounge and kitchen
- Guest room
- Laundry room/drying facilities
- Disabled shower room
- Gardens with lawns and flower beds.

Service facilities

- A dedicated member of staff providing support
- Alarm call system linked to a community alarm service
- Heat and smoke detectors/ Fire alarm system
- CCTV and door entry system
- Gas central heating
- Induction loop for the hard of hearing
- Car park.

Eligibility

The scheme is for people who:

- Are usually above retirement age
- Are resident in the Mid Suffolk District Council area
- Live elsewhere but have a strong social reason for needing to move to the area.
