Cheshire Court Extra Care Sheltered Scheme

Cheshire Court provides quality self-contained accommodation for people over 55 years of age

Where are we?

Cheshire Court is an Extra Care Sheltered Scheme for over 55s and is situated in Ravenall Close, off School Lane in Shard End.

The Scheme is within walking distance of the Shard End and Heathway shops. It is accessible to doctors and is close to local bus routes for Birmingham City Centre.

There are churches nearby and the local Day Centres put on events such as tea dances and lunches.

Self-contained Flats

Each tenant is individually assessed by Social Services. Working in partnership, Social Services and Mercian ensure tenants can stay in their home and receive the additional care they need in secure accommodation.

Cheshire Court has 25 flats, which are designed for the disabled.

Each flat comprises a lounge, kitchen, bathroom and bedroom. Cookers and fridge/freezers are installed in all properties and are maintained by Mercian.



Facilities & Services

- There is lift access to all floors
- A Guest Room is available for a nominal fee for use when friends or family wish to stay

- All flats have orange pull cords and 24-hour cover in the event of an emergency. A Sheltered Scheme Officer resides on site and is on duty each week day
- The Officer will call each tenant daily, during the week to monitor all is well
- Cheshire Court has a communal lounge for tenants to meet and join in with any social events that are planned at the scheme
- Social events vary from coffee mornings, afternoon teas, bingo, darts, cards, suppers, lunches and day trips
- There is a Laundry with washing machines and tumble driers
- Contractors maintain the communal gardens and clean the outside of all windows
- Tenants can register with the Ring and Ride service



Support

The service aims to offer tenants the opportunity to live independently within a secure environment.

Staff deliver caring, assistance and supportive advice on a range of subjects.

A Support Plan will be offered to you after you have settled in.

The Plan will highlight your needs to make your life easier.
