Although the Association does not provide any domestic nursing or medical services, you will be reassured to know that the resident staff are there to help in an emergency. They can also assist in the co-ordination of social services and general welfare.

## What does it cost?

The rents are modest reflecting the status of the Association, but also take into account a returnable 'Loan Stock' payment which each new resident is obliged to pay. The benefit of paying a loan stock ensures that your rent is kept lower than market rents. Details of the Loan Stock Scheme are available upon request.
