Broadway Manor

Broadway Manor is a housing gem that lies at the heart of the Broadway Village, the largest of the Pickering and Ferens Homes village-style developments.



Located just beyond the short tree-lined avenue that bears the same name on Holderness Road, this superb East Hull development celebrated its 10th anniversary in the summer of 2005.

Broadway Manor is set in beautiful and spacious landscaped grounds which include a bowling green and a nature area with a wildlife pond, all accessible by residents. The green, in front of the Manor, not only provides space for social activities but is also an attractive focal point for the residents.

Broadway Manor has 36 sheltered housing flats, including one flat suitable for use by disabled persons, and good communal facilities. Residents can also use two Pop-In Centres at nearby Majestic Court or at Broadway Pavilion. The wide range of activities available includes exercise sessions, bingo, darts and evening entertainments and if residents wish to be involved in the planning of events and activities there is plenty of scope for them to join in the fun.

The Scheme Manager, who lives close by, is available to help and reassure residents and encourages them to lead full and active lives.

Broadway Village consists of 187 bungalows, all of which have easy access to Broadway Manor and to local facilities.


