The project comprised the construction of 50 very sheltered flats, consisting of five interconnecting blocks of accommodation to ground and first floors. A large lounge dining area was also included, with additional rooms for resident's use including a hairdressing salon and laundry area.

The substructure consisted of traditional strip foundations and concrete blockwork. Internally a variety of finishes were utilised including traditional plaster, specialist selfcolour render and cedar cladding. ground floor was predominately tiled whilst the first floor was carpeted.

Externally the building fabric was treated in a similar fashion as the internal finish with a combination of render, timber, brickwork and zinc cladding, the most striking feature being a curved timber 'brise soleil' to the lounge area.

The roof was constructed of 'standing seam zinc' whilst a blend of hard and soft landscaping finished an aesthetically pleasing yet functional building.
