About the scheme

Thornhills is located in the town of Widnes. The scheme has 16 self contained flats specifically designed for older people, and provides an opportunity for independent living in a safe, comfortable and secure environment.

The properties are set over two floors, with stairs and stairs lift leading to the first floor accommodation. All the flats have either one or two bedrooms, with separate lounge, kitchen and bathroom.

A short walk from Thornhills is a GP surgery, chemist, dentist, post office®, fish and chip shop, hairdresser, bakery, grocery store and newsagent. There is also a community centre with a café nearby.

Directly outside of the scheme is a bus stop with a local service to Widnes town centre. Within the town you will find a variety of shops and amenities. There is also a station a mile from Thornhills which can take you to towns and cities further afield.

Facilities

- 16 self contained flats
- 24 hour emergency response service via an intercom and pull cords within each property
- Door fitted with intercoms
- Stair lifts
- Gas central heating
- Communal lounge with kitchen facilities
- Regular activities are available for those who want to get involved, these include a coffee morning and kurling
- Landscaped communal gardens
- Guest room for the family and friends of residents to use at a small charge

Who can apply?

Thornhills is a scheme that has been designed for older people or those with disabilities.
