About the scheme

George Downing House is located on the outskirts of the city of Plymouth in Crownhill. The scheme has 26 homes specifically designed for older people, and offers an opportunity for independent living in a safe, comfortable and secure environment.

The scheme is set over 2 floors with stairs leading to the first floor accommodation. There are 24 one bedroom flats and 2, two bedroom flats, with communal gas central heating and communal garden.

Within a fifteen minute walk from the scheme there are some local shops including a post office®, GP surgery, chemist, as well as a supermarket and various other shops.

There is a bus stop close to the scheme with links to the city centre and the hospital, which takes about 30 minutes.

Facilities

- 26 homes
- 24 emergency support, 7 days a week, via our staff and our in house control centre
- Security door entry to the main front door that can be operated from each flat
- Communal Gas Central Heating
- Communal lounge, where weekly coffee mornings are held and occasional social events
- Communal laundry room with washing machine and dryer for residents use
- Communal garden
- The scheme has a range of visiting services including hairdressers, chiropodist, optician and dentist
- There is guest suite available for a small fee for relatives and family

Who can apply?

George Downing House has been specifically designed for older people or those with disabilities.
