About the scheme

Sutton Heights is located in the Sutton Heights area of Sheffield. The scheme has 20 homes specifically designed for older people, and offers an opportunity for independent living in a safe, comfortable and secure environment.

The scheme consists of 5 blocks, each with 2 flats upstairs and 2 flats downs stair. Three of the blocks have access to outside from both up and downstairs. From upstairs this is via wooden bridge's, that lead outside. The flats all have separate lounge, kitchen and bathroom, with night storage heating and communal gardens with seating areas.

A short walk from the scheme there are three GP surgeries, a post office®, chemists and some local shops. A ten minute walk away there is a shopping centre and close by there is access to some beautiful countryside. Near to the scheme is a bus stop, with buses taking you into Sheffield town centre, there is also a tram service. In Sheffield town centre there is also the main line train station, which can take you to towns and cities further afield.

Facilities

- 20 homes
- 24 hour emergency response service via an intercom and pull cords within each property
- Night storage heating
- Communal lounge with kitchen facilities, where events are held such as coffee mornings, bingo, one man shows. They also have ploughman and pie and peas lunches
- Communal laundry room with washing machines and dryers for residents use
- Guest room available for residents family and friends to use for a small charge
- Communal garden with seating
- Visiting hairdressers, chiropodists and cleaners

Who can apply?

Sutton Heights is a scheme that has been designed for older people or those with disabilities.
