We provide a range of services, such as:

- Assistance with a 'good morning' start to the day, with help to get up, wash, shower or bath, get dressed and have breakfast.
- Shopping support alongside our customer or alternatively we can come in, agree a shopping list, go to the shops, come back and put it all away.
- Preparation of food and drink.
- Ensuring a timely prompt for medication when due.
- Undertaking domestic tasks such as cleaning, laundry and ironing either on a regular basis or as a 'spring clean', whatever the season.
- Provision of a respite service. If you are performing the role of principal carer, then you may need support during your time off each week.
- Pampering sessions the occasional visit to organise bathing, clean clothes, fresh bedding and a thoughtfully prepared meal before bedtime.
- At the end of each day, some help with getting ready for bed.





Our achievements and recognition for rural innovation:

The first major project for the charity was to secure funds and partnership support to transform the former residential care home (that had started life as a Victorian workhouse) into a purpose built Community Resource Centre and housing project for older people. The Resource Centre opened in 2005 and acts as a hub for delivering a wide range of health and social care services and activities to older people living across the Bell View catchment area

In January 2008, the charity purchased an older person's day-care business from a private sector provider and established a new social enterprise Bell View Care Ltd.

Since 2005, Bell View has been recognised for many of its achievements.
