Eligibility Categories*

If you have difficulty getting to a high street opticians without assistance and are:

- Aged 60 or over or under 16
- Aged under 19 and in full time education
- Diagnosed with Diabetes or Glaucoma or considered to be at risk of Glaucoma
- Aged 40 or over and the parent, brother, sister, son or daughter of a person diagnosed with Glaucoma
- Registered Blind or Partially Sighted
- Eligible for a NHS Complex Lens Voucher
- Claiming Benefit (pension credit guarantee, income support/jobseekers allowance, tax credits)
- On a Low Income and named on a valid HC2 or HC3 Certificate
