Our Services

Domiciliary/Home Care is the range of services we can put in place to support you, in your own home. We will assist you to remain living as independently as possible by doing tasks such as preparing meals, administering personal care & medication as applicable, general housekeeping – such as cleaning and doing laundry or going shopping.

We can arrange a carer to come in either a few times a day within designated times that suit you e.g., 9am to assist with getting out of bed and helping make breakfast or come in just for half an hour to assist with medication management.

Sometimes there is 'sit in' service for companionship where a carer comes in to sit with you for a chat/company or take you out for a given amount of time as you require.



Nursing/Complex Care is when we can arrange a fully managed qualified nurse led care services, enabling individuals with more complex, severe or challenging conditions to continue living independently in the comfort of their own home. Our NMC registered nurses and specialist trained carers will support you with specialist care such as tracheostomy care, ventilator care, PEG feeding, stoma care and complex continence needs, such as catheter care.

Live-in is when our professionally trained, caring and passionate care worker moves into our client home, full time to live with them and support their care needs. They will assist with all activities of daily living such personal care, administering medication, eating & drinking/dietary & nutritional needs, companionship and Support, general housekeeping/domestic tasks. Normally the carers can stay with you for a week or two weeks at a time, however we listen to what suits you best.

How we recruit our staff...

We recognise the importance of compliance, (we are CQC registered). Our recruitment team ensures that all our healthcare staff are fully screened. All healthcare staff:

- Complete our application form, with full details of career history, qualifications and a declaration on criminal proceedings/convictions.
- Have eligibility to work in the UK checks.
- Undergo an enhanced DBS check.
- Have a face-to-face interview to verify documents, assess suitability and confirm language ability.
- Have at least two references including most recent employer.
- The Nursing and Midwifery Council (NMC) Pin for registered nurses

We comply, at all times with the latest NHS Employers Check Standards, when providing care staff into your home.
