Whitelaw Court is located in a quiet area of historic Dunfermline in the Kingdom of Fife. The development has attractive landscaped gardens to the rear of the building. The development has excellent transport links to the nearby town centre and there are great rail links Cowdenbeath, Kirkcaldy, Dundee, Edinburgh and Glasgow.

Whitelaw Court is set out over three levels; all except two basement flats are served by both a lift and stairs ensuring easy access throughout the development. It also offers an attractive residents' lounge overlooking the beautiful landscaped gardens which are frequently used by residents. An assisted bathroom, hairdressing room and laundry facilities are available for residents to use.

The front door of the development is covered by a secure door entry system.
