

Roseberry Court is a supported housing scheme providing support for older people

### **ACCOMMODATION**

- 30, Rented one-bedroom self-contained flats.
- Each property has separate kitchen, bathroom and hall.
- All flats have a television and telephone point.
- In the main block, flats above ground floor have lift access.

# **SCHEME AMENITIES**

- The scheme has communal gardens with seating
- Parking for residents and visitors.
- Ground floor flats have patio and garden access.
- Communal areas include laundry and refuse facilities.
- A guestroom is available for the use of customers' visitors.
- Handrails fitted in all main corridors.
- There is a lift to the first and second floors of the main block. Other first floor flats have stair access.

## **SERVICES**

- Alarm call system in each flat with a pendant.
- Staff work at the scheme each day.
- Out of hours response.
- Staff provide housing related support to customers, to meet the needs of each individual.
- Heating & Lighting of individual flats is not included in the weekly service charge.
- Regular Customer meetings.

### **VISITING SERVICES**

- Chiropodist
- Hairdresser
- Optical Services are available from local health centre

#### LOCAL AMENITIES

Roseberry Court is located between Shenfield and Billericay

Short walking distance from local shops and public house Bus stops are outside the entrance to the scheme, giving access to Brentwood and Basildon.

The nearest railway station for the Network and London is Shenfield.
