Where is Crownway Community Centre?

From the North/South

From Haydock Island (M6, junction 23) follow the signs for A49 South, Newton-le-Willows. Travel along the A49 (Ashton Rd) for about a mile. At the mini roundabout, turn right onto the A572 (Crow Lane East).

Follow the A572 for a further mile to a set of traffic lights with a petrol station on the left. Turn left into Market St and after about 300 yards turn right into Crown Street. The Crownway Community Centre is on your right.

There is a large car park off Market St and opposite St John's Church, and limited parking in Crown St and adjacent Bertram St.

From the East/West

From junction 10 of the M62 take the A49 (Newton Road/ Winwick Road). Continue for about two miles, past Newton Railway Station along Church St/ High St. At the mini roundabout, turn left onto the A572 (Crow Lane East). Then follow the directions in italics above.
