#### Local area

Bolton is a town in Greater Manchester, close to the West Pennine Moors. It has a large central library, aquarium, museum, art gallery and concert halls. You'll also find shopping centres, a Victorian market hall, pubs, restaurants and cafés.

There are some lovely scenic walks to be enjoyed in the surrounding area. The historic Smithills Hall manor house contains fine examples of architecture through the ages. The Hall is set in formal gardens next to the West Pennine moors.

For sports enthusiasts the town is home to football, rugby and cricket clubs. The brand new Bolton One leisure centre has a swimming pool and a wide range of sports facilities.

## Theatre and Festivals

Bolton's 26 conservation areas contain 700 listed buildings, many of which are in the town centre. There is parkland at the Victorian Queen's Park, Leverhulme Park and other open spaces in the surrounding area.

Bolton has several theatres including the Octagon, Bolton Little Theatre and the Phoenix Theatre Company. The Bolton Symphony Orchestra performs regular concerts at the Albert Halls and Victoria Hall in the town centre. Also of interest is the museum and art gallery, which has a fine collection of both local and international art.

## Transport links

The development is conveniently situated just off the A579, near junction 4 of the M61.

Regular bus and coach services run to many locations, including nearby Bury, Wigan and Chorley. The town is also served by a mainline station with frequent trains running into Manchester, Wigan, Southport and Blackburn.
