### **About Laxton Court**

Laxton Court is a sheltered housing scheme for people over the age of 60 years who wish to live independently but within a secure and comfortable environment amongst people of a similar age. There is a Sheltered Housing Officer who can co-ordinate support services for the tenants if required and all flats are fitted with a 24 hour emergency call out system.

# **Description and Location**

Laxton Court is a modern purpose built sheltered housing scheme. It is conveniently situated within the main Thornton Heath shopping area. Buses serving the surrounding areas stop right outside the development.

# **Building Layout**

The development consists of 20 self contained onebedroom flats on four floors. All flats are lift served. There is a comfortable, well furnished lounge and dining room where residents enjoy social activities. There is a laundry room for the use of residents, and there is also a guest room which can be hired on a nightly basis

### **Communal Facilities**

There is a comfortable, well furnished lounge and dining room which is used for tea and coffee mornings, fish and chip lunches, dominos and board games. There is a dominos club and a social club. Occasional barbeques, trips and parties are arranged and there is a regular church service to which everyone is welcomed. There is a roof terrace where residents can enjoy the summer weather.

## **Local Transport and Area**

Bus routes, 250, 68, 50, 178, 480 stop right outside Laxton Court and serve all the surrounding areas. Thornton Heath British Rail Station is about 5 minutes walk along Parchmore Road. The newly opened Thornton Heath leisure centre with swimming and sport facilities is within a few minutes walk on the High Street. Thornton Heath Library is a little further along Brigstock Road and can easily be reached by a short bus journey.
