Directions from M4 via Bath

- Leave the M4 at Junction 18 and join the A46 direction Bath
- Travel for 7.7 miles and exit at the intersection to join the A4 direction Bath
- Remain on the A4 for approximately 1.5 miles, and at the crossroads turn right on Lansdown Road
- Continue straight ahead on Lansdown Road, and take the 3rd road on the left (onto Julian Road)
- Continue on Julian Road and then onto Weston Road
- After passing Royal Victoria Park on your left, take the 4th turning right onto Western Park.

Directions from M4 avoiding Bath

- Leave the M4 at Junction 18 and join the A46 direction Bath
- Travel for 3.7 miles and at the roundabout take the 3rd exit onto the A420 direction Bristol



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- After 0.8 miles turn left onto Freezinghill Lane direction Bath Race Course
- Travel for three miles, after passing Bath Race Course on the right, turn right onto Lansdown Lane
- Continue for one mile and at the mini roundabout turn left into Weston Village
- Travel through the village for 500 yards and bear left onto Crown Hill which leads onto Weston Park.
