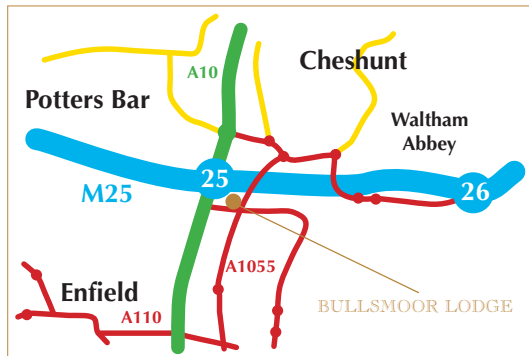

Bullsmoor Lodge is a purpose built Care Hotel with 44 ensuite bedrooms, situated at the end of Bullsmoor Lane close to the Hertford Road at Waltham Cross, and was opened by Scimitar in June 1997.

Immediately at the entrance hall you will experience a warm welcoming environment. The feeling of space has been built into the design and very easy access is afforded into the main Lounge and Dining Room and then on to the spacious rear garden which has a sitting out patio and lawn which is secluded and sunny. There is a separate large quiet lounge on the top floor overlooking Bullsmoor Lane. There is ease of access throughout the building and a licensed bar in the main lounge. There are two modern passenger lifts and the Manager's office is situated on the ground floor immediately by the entrance hall.

All bedrooms are light and airy with a homely yet modern character and have ensuite facilities with a private telephone, television and an emergency call system. Staffing is on a 24 hour, 365 day a year basis, available for assistance with personal care, dressing and any Residents' requirement at any time. Care staff are not intrusive and will assist as much or as little as a Resident may need. Residents' rooms are cleaned and attended to on a daily basis and there is a full in-house laundry and a mobile shop. An in-house mini-surgery is held on a weekly basis provided by the local GP but Residents are free to retain their own Doctor if preferred. Waltham Cross main shopping centre is just a short walk away for those that are ambulant.

Meals, which are freshly prepared and served each day by the cook and catering staff, are nutritious and wholesome. Any dietary variation or personal request is attended to. There are no 'visiting hours' as Residents' guests and families are welcomed at any time.
