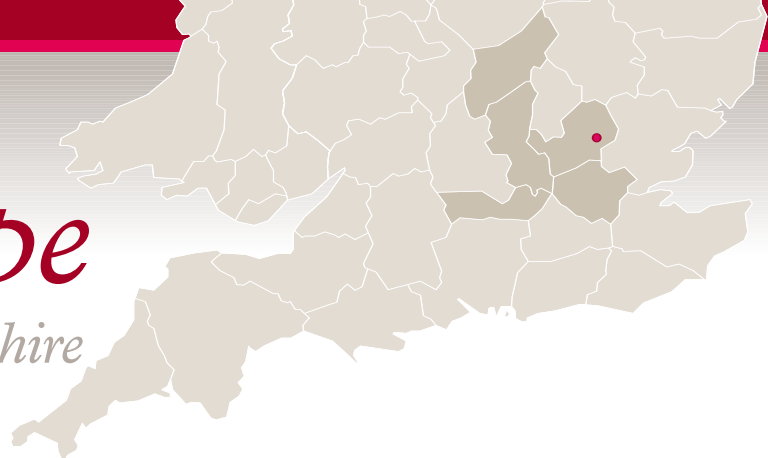


Willowthorpe

Travelling on the A10 exit onto the A414 signposted Chelmsford. At the Amwell Roundabout take the third exit onto the B181 signposted Stanstead Abbots. Passing St Margarets train station on your left continue over the bridge and Willowthorpe is immediately on your left opposite two shops.
