

Haven House, Leadgate

Independent Living for the Over 55s

Haven House, Leadgate opened in 1971. The scheme has recently undergone major refurbishment to develop 12 single and 9 double apartments. The accommodation is roomy and the double apartments have an en-suite shower room.

The scheme is in Leadgate which has plenty of shops, a doctors and a Post Office within easy walking distance. Leadgate is built on a relatively flat area making it accessible for those with mobility problems. There is a regular bus service to Consett, which is just over one mile away. From Consett there are regular buses to Durham, Newcastle and the Metro Centre which you can catch if you want a trip out.

There is a good community spirit within the scheme and tenants hold regular coffee mornings and lunch clubs.

The apartments have new bathrooms and kitchens and an upgraded communal washing and drying area. A new CCTV door entry has been fitted in the court meaning tenants can look at their own TV screens to see who is at the main entrance door.

There is a communal laundry room, a wet room and a multifunctional room for the use of a chiropodist, hairdresser or for other treatments. The communal lounge is modern and adjoins a well-equipped kitchen. There is also a guest-room, a large garden with an exercise path and a motorised scooter store.



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
