

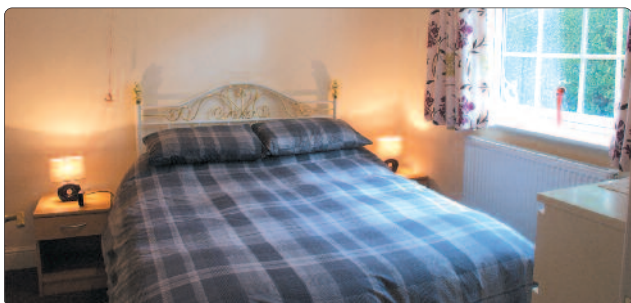
Accommodation at Homestead Cottages

Homestead Cottages provide sheltered housing in a caring environment for both single people and couples.

We have 24 single-storey cottages arranged around a village green, creating what residents describe as 'an oasis of calm' and mutual support. This special atmosphere allows people to be independent and as private or sociable as they wish.

There's easy access to shopping, medical and other essential services.

A service of prayer and Holy Communion is held monthly.

Other mobile services, such as hairdressing and a shop visit Homestead Cottages regularly.

A resident part-time Warden is on hand to offer support and assistance. A very efficient Call-Care System is available at all times.

The Saxton Memorial Hall provides a space for various social and community activities as well as companionship.

People seeking sheltered accommodation from all Christian denominations are free to apply.

Life at Homestead Cottages

The best way to get a feel for what life at Homestead Cottages is like is to listen to what some of the residents have to say!

Peace of mind There's no need to worry about running and maintaining your own home. It's clear that people find a 'home from home' where they live happily in a close community with like-minded people.
