





Ask one of the team for our activities schedule.








The research found that after moving in, residents felt a significant improvement to their physical and mental health.







The number of residents suffering with clinical levels of depression fell by 64.3% over 18 months










Light and spacious apartments

- The village was built in 2017
- Our 260 homes are made up of one and two bedroom apartments
- Affordable living options are provided through social rent or shared ownership
- Properties can also be purchased outright
- The village forms part of regeneration specialist, St Modwen's, £1 billion Longbridge regeneration scheme

The village is situated on the edge of Longbridge town centre. Once home to the Austin Mini factory, momentum has been building over recent years to transform the 468-acre site to reconnect and rejuvenate the area. The local council are investing in creating new opportunities in the area to inspire the next generation.
