

NOMES IN APPLEBY BLUE

The almshouse will consist of 57 affordable self-contained spacious apartments designed specifically for people over the age of 60 to live independently for as long as possible. All homes and facilities have been designed to the highest standards to their life stages and emerging health conditions.



In addition to the availability of the charity's onsite team, every home is able to be fitted with the most modern wifi-enabled assisted living technology that can be added to when needed e.g. emergency pullcords (as standard), falls sensors, suit the needs of residents through all room temperature monitoring, giving residents and their relatives the security of knowing their parent and loved one are safe and looking after themselves.

> Typically, the flats will benefit from large, airy lounges with good views on to the street, fully fitted kitchens and well-designed accessible shower rooms. With plenty of storage space and efficient methods of heating, these homes really are fit for the 21st



Facilities

In addition to the stunning and busy community spaces, Appleby Blue will provide some beautiful 'resident only' spaces including a private 24 hour lounge, a 'spa room', hairdressing facilities and a splendid roof garden to grow fruit and vegetables, or simply relax.



There will be on site staff with specialist skills in older person's living, helping residents navigate the health and state benefits systems, supporting them to live independently and safely, building friendships and animating the will keep everyone active, healthy and contributing to their community.

We also want Appleby Blue to set a new benchmark for over 60's social housing. We want to be able to learn from others, and will be encouraging health researchers to become part of what we do at Appleby Blue. We think our residents will be proud community spaces with activities that of influencing a new wave of older person's home building and will know that Appleby Blue is the best!

Who can apply?

Eligible applicants will be a single person or couple, both over the age of 60. Couples could include lifelong companions, siblings or parents with a child over 60 years. These households would qualify for a 2 bedroom apartment. Eligible applicants will have lived in Southwark for at least the last 3 years. As a charity, USTSC can only help those in the greatest need of housing. Eligible applicants will typically have a low income or limited capital, live in Council, Social or Private rented housing. Homeowners and those with significant assets will usually not qualify.







Residents living in Appleby Blue will particularly suit those people who are living in Southwark Council housing, or other social housing, where their home might be too big, too expensive, or an area where they feel lonely or isolated. Southwark Council will be able to fill half of the new homes with those who approach them; the other half will be residents who have applied directly to United St Saviour's Charity via their existing landlord or independently. We expect that lots of people will be interested in Appleby Blue and there is a chance that we will be oversubscribed. Offers will be made

to applicants with the highest level of housing need as assessed by United St Saviour's Charity.
