Established more than 100 years ago by Joseph Rowntree to provide good housing for communities, we are the Joseph Rowntree Housing Trust (JRHT), a registered housing association and care provider in York and the North East. New Earswick is the original 'garden village' and a template used by later communities established around the UK.

Our mission is developing strong, empowered communities without poverty or isolation.

We manage around 2,500 homes, half of which are located in the village of New Earswick, York. The rest are spread across Yorkshire and the North East, including Scarborough, Beverley, Leeds and Hartlepool. We have flats, houses and bungalows suitable for single people, couples, families with children and older people, together with sheltered and retirement living schemes with extra care services.

We act as landlord to residents renting our properties and, in certain locations, offer additional residential care services. If you would like to own your home we also offer affordable shared ownership options.

The garden village of New Earswick sits a few miles north of the centre of York, the beautiful and historic capital of the North. A thriving community of all ages, since its creation by Joseph Rowntree in 1904, New Earswick has kept its emphasis on green spaces and you'll find a Designated Educational Nature Reserve and allotments close by. New Lodge also brings improvements in the wider village, including new public spaces for play, leisure and sport.

The River Foss runs alongside the village offering a picturesque walk into the centre of York. One of the UK's best-loved destinations, York offers a wealth of year-round activities and interest, from York Minster and Theatre Royal to racing at the Knavesmire. Take your pick of world-class museums, galleries, top class restaurants, seasonal festivals, bustling daily markets, unique heritage and culture, all just a short bus ride away.

Regular bus services connect the village to the city and shopping centres at Clifton Moor and Monks Cross, which offer spacious and varied out-to-town shopping.

### Flexible apartments

Our independent living apartments offer a wealth of high quality features, including:

- Quality fitted kitchens with ceramic hob, extractor fan and accessible mid-height integrated ovens.
- Gas fired communal heating, with thermostatically controlled, low surface temperature radiators connected to a Nest Learning Thermostat to maintain optimum warmth and reduce bills.
- Combined video display and intercom door entry systems.
- Double glazed windows with trickle vents.
- Telephone and TV aerial points in both lounge and bedroom(s).
- Slip resistant flooring in bathrooms and kitchens.
- Level access showers.
- Mains connected smoke and heat detectors.
- Spacious balconies or patios to some apartments.

#### Care accommodation

Enjoy comfort and care in our registered 45-bed care home:

- Spacious private bed/sitting rooms with fitted storage.
- Fully accessible, level access wet rooms.
- Dedicated care call system.
- Choice of two dining rooms.
- Communal lounge, garden room and quite space.
- On-site hairdresser.
- Secure sensory garden.


# The New Lodge Community

New Lodge consists of four buildings providing a range of accommodation types.

**Rowntree Lodge** - a mix of registered care beds and rented apartments: available from late 2019.

**Parker Court** - a mix of shared ownership and rented apartments: available from late 2019.

**Unwin Court** and **Seebohm House** – a mix of shared ownership and rented apartments: available from Spring 2021.



### Shared ownership, care and rental options

### Shared ownership

Shared ownership allows you to buy a percentage of the full market value of a property, from 25% to a maximum of 75%. A cross between buying and renting, you pay a fixed rent on the unpurchased portion.

Enjoy all the benefits of shared ownership:

- Buying a shared ownership property is the same as buying a property outright, in that it will be yours, and yours alone to live in and enjoy.
- The property will be sold to you on a 125-year leasehold basis.
- A monthly rent will be charged by JRHT in respect of the unpurchased portion of the property. However, where a 75% purchase is made, you will not be required to pay rent on the final unpurchased 25%.
- You have the option to buy a bigger percentage of the property at a later date.
- You will be required to pay a service charge, regardless of tenure type or percentage of property owned.
- You will be responsible for any internal repairs to your home, but we will take care of maintaining the building, communal areas and all external landscaped grounds.

Flexible and affordable, shared ownership offers you a great way to buy your next home, with the advantages of releasing cash from the sale of your current property and even a mortgage free retirement.

### Renting

There are 70 one and two bedroom apartments available to rent at New Lodge. Eligible applicants will need to complete our Housing Registration Information Pack and meet our criteria. We base our decision on a points system, which includes assessing your current home and how this falls short of your current needs.

Applications for all social rented extra care apartments will be considered by an Allocation Panel comprising representatives of JRHT and local authority partners.
