Noahs Court

Noahs Court is situated in the village of Turners Hill which has a general store with post office, a hairdressers and a florist. The nearest GP surgery is in the next village but the general store offers a prescription drop off and collection facility. They can also deliver your groceries if required.

There is a very good bus service from the village to the nearby towns of East Grinstead, Crawley and Haywards Heath. Train stations are located in all of these towns for travel to other areas. The scheme has 24 homes specifically designed for older people.

The scheme is set out over 2 floors with stairs leading to the first floor accommodation. There are a mixture of one-bedroom flats and studio apartments throughout the scheme.

All of the properties have gas central heating and are fully double glazed.

The properties are all linked by an intercom system via a pull cord in each room, to the Scheme Manager when on duty, or to our supporting control centre out of hours.

Residents are secure in the knowledge that there is always someone available to offer support in an emergency 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

All homes and communal areas are fitted with individual smoke detectors linked to the 24-hour control centre.

Magnetic fire door closers operate throughout the communal areas of the scheme in case of fire.

Facilities

Security door entry to the main front door that can be operated from each flat.

There is a communal lounge with adjoining kitchen where a variety of functions are held on a regular

basis including coffee mornings, bingo and darts sessions.

There is a communal laundry with washing machines and tumble dryers for the residents use.

Pretty communal gardens and residents parking.

The services from various agencies such as Age Concern and the WRVS are available

locally and can be contacted by the scheme manager on request.

Location

Noahs Court is situated in small village of Turners Hill which has a general store, post office, hairdressers, florist and a pub all within a short walk.

There is a regular bus service to nearby villages and the larger Towns of East Grinstead, Haywards Heath and Crawley.

Who can apply?

Noahs Court has been specifically designed for older people or those with disabilities, who live locally and are in need of some support. The scheme offers an opportunity for independent living in a safe, comfortable and secure environment.

Applications should be made to Mid Sussex District Council, unless you are currently a tenant of Downland Housing Association.
