Postley Farm

Postley Farm consists of 12 bungalows and thirty flats. There is a communal lounge where social functions are held, including bingo, coffee mornings and lunch clubs.

The social committee arranges outings throughout the year. Several shops, a post office and doctor's surgery are within walking distance and a local bus route is close by.

To find us take the first turning on the right off Broadoak Avenue, which is off Cripple Street.

Call Centre

All of our sheltered housing schemes, semi sheltered housing and community lifelines are linked to the Invicta telecare centre.

This centre is operational 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.

When an emergency call is activated from your lifeline the telecare centre can view your details on a computer screen and will be able to talk to you to ascertain your difficulty. They will then get in touch with your contacts or the emergency Services as appropriate.
