

Introduction

The accommodation consists of 11 studio flats and 34 one bedroom self-contained flats with walk-in showers.

It offers a guest room for visitors, an attractive communal garden and residents parking.

The scheme is close to Fencepiece Road and is well served with public transport to Barkingside, Ilford and Romford. The scheme is well situated for a G.P., a chemist, a supermarket and other local shops and amenities.



Aims of the scheme

The main aim of the scheme is to promote independent living with additional care packages as and when required. The scheme offers good quality accommodation for life and tenancies are let on an assured basis.

Who can live at Bernard House?

The scheme has been specifically designed for adults aged 55 years plus who require support to live independently in their own homes.
