Sheltered Housing with extra care services for the frail elderly

Christian Smith House

Christian Smith House is a sheltered housing scheme on the outskirts of Maidenhead. It was recently refurbished to provide 32 apartments for people aged over sixty. Fifteen apartments are available for people who have been assessed by Social Services as needing high levels of care and support because of frailty or disability. The 15 extra care tenancies will offer people the opportunity of keeping their own front door, more control over how they live and is an alternative to entering long-term residential care. The other 17 tenancies are available for people who wish to live in sheltered accommodation; these are available through application to Maidenhead & District Housing Association or the Royal Borough of Windsor and Maidenhead Housing Policy Unit.

What is available at Christian Smith House?

Both housing with support and 24 hour cover for Social Services care are available at Christian Smith House depending on what is needed.

Housing and Support Services

- Individual assured tenancies rent, service and community charges and utility bills apply
- A Sheltered Housing Manager employed by Maidenhead & District Housing Association contacts each tenant daily
- A Manager is on site daily
- 24 hour cover by intercom alarm system when manager is off duty or off site
- Mobile relief manager on call to cover manager's days off and holidays
- Manager liaison with carers, relatives and other agencies
- 24 hour repair service
- Help and advice about housing benefit and money problems
- Communal facilities hairdressers room, lounge and gardens all maintained to high standards
- Laundry facilities
- TV licence is covered by service charge

What is Sheltered Housing with Extra Care?

People who can no longer manage in their own homes and who need more intensive or high levels of personal care can be offered the benefits of sheltered housing plus the personal care and support that they need. The care is arranged by a Social Services care manager following an assessment of needs, which will identify those aspects of daily livin, which people can continue to provide for themselves and those which they need assistance with in order that they remain as independent as possible. This care is available 7 days a week.

Personal Care needs can include help required with:

Washing

Dressing/undressing

Bathing

Catheter and Stoma care

Laundry

- Medication
- Shopping

- Meal preparation
- Assistance to and from bed

There will be a separate charge for care services which Social Services calculates according to how much income a tenant has. Christian Smith House is not a nursing or residential home. People do not occupy rooms; they have an assured tenancy of a self-contained apartment or studio. If tenants are in need of medical services the doctor and district nurses will visit to provide them.

Intermediary Care

In partnership with Social Services, we are offering short term intermediary care at Christian Smith House. This care in the community is designed to help people who are ready to be discharged from hospital, but are not quite ready to return home and live independently. A guest room is available for relatives. The room has to be booked through the Sheltered Housing Manager. There is a charge for this facility.
