Bethersden Court

Bethersden Court consists of 23 bedsits and 14 bungalows, with a large parking area for tenants and visitors.

There is a lift to the first floor where you will find a laundry and hairdressing room. The library is on the ground floor. Coffee mornings and bingo sessions are held weekly.

Close by are a variety of shops including Fish & Chips, Mace mini-market and a Charity shop. There is a bus stop to town close by.

Call Centre

All of our sheltered housing schemes, semi sheltered housing and community lifelines are linked to the Invicta telecare centre.

This centre is operational 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.

When an emergency call is activated from your lifeline the telecare centre can view your details on a computer screen and will be able to talk to you to ascertain your difficulty. They will then get in touch with your contacts or the emergency Services as appropriate.
