St Stephens has 4 one-bedroom bungalows and 8 one-bedroom flats overlooking communal gardens and parking area. Church Street has twelve one bedroom flats with door entry system.

The day centre is home to many social events including bingo and video club.

Close by are 2 large supermarkets, two pubs and Tovil working man's club. College Road surgery is a short distance away this route will then take you into Town.

Call Centre

All of our sheltered housing schemes, semi sheltered housing and community lifelines are linked to the Invicta telecare centre.

This centre is operational 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.

When an emergency call is activated from your lifeline the telecare centre can view your details on a computer screen and will be able to talk to you to ascertain your difficulty. They will then get in touch with your contacts or the emergency Services as appropriate.
