McCabe Close

McCabe Close consists of 23 bungalows, plus 6 adapted properties for the disabled. There is ample parking around the scheme.

The day centre on site is host to a range of activities including lunch clubs, physiotherapy sessions and chiropody. The tenants social club organises outings and coffee clubs.

Call Centre

All of our sheltered housing schemes, semi sheltered housing and community lifelines are linked to the Invicta telecare centre.

This centre is operational 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.

When an emergency call is activated from your lifeline the telecare centre can view your details on a computer screen and will be able to talk to you to ascertain your difficulty. They will then get in touch with your contacts or the emergency Services as appropriate.
