Glanogwr House is a retirement scheme development of 33 self contained flats and 1 bedsit managed by Hafod Housing Association. The scheme is designed for the elderly and located close to Bridgend town centre. Residents can be assured of complete independence, with each flat having its own front door.

The Association also provides the services of a warden who acts as a good neighbour in cases of emergency. The scheme also benefits from a fully furnished guest bedroom (with en-suite bathroom) that is available for use by residents' visitors.








Location

Glanogwr House is in an ideal location overlooking Newbridge Fields, close to Bridgend town centre. There is easy access to local shopping, post office, banks, and public libraries.

Rents & Service Charges

As a tenant of Glanogwr House you will benefit from the security of having an assured tenancy agreement, unfortunately though you will not have the right to buy. Whilst residing in Glanogwr House the Association will take care of the day-to-day management of the building, including maintenance, landscaping and the warden service.

The rent is set at an affordable level within the guidelines set by the Welsh Assembly Government. Rents are charged weekly and will be reviewed on an annual basis. A Service Charge is also charged weekly, to cover the following services;

- Warden Services
- Warden Call System
- Door Entry System
- Communal Heating and Lighting
- · Washing & Drying Equipment
- Furniture for the Communal Lounge
