HOPKINS COURT

Hopkins Court is situated off Nottingham Road in Eastwood Town Centre. It can be reached by turning into Albert Street or Victoria Street. It is located next to the DH Lawrence Shop/Museum.

The complex consists of 48 self contained flats. Facilities include a guest room, laundry and a communal lounge with separate disabled toilets.
