Venn Court sheltered housing scheme is situated on Scott Avenue, Beeston.

It consists of 35 self contained flats.

Facilities on site include a lift, common room, lounge, guest room, communal kitchen, laundry room.

High Street shops, Post Office, Doctors Surgeries, Library, Council Offices are within a short walking distance of the scheme.

There is also a good bus service to Nottingham, Derby and Long Eaton.
