Sheltered housing is a block or group of self contained flats or bungalows specifically designed or adapted for older people.

All our designated sheltered housing accommodation is linked through a speech call system to the Scheme Manager when on duty and at all other times to a Control Centre enabling 24 hour access to assistance in an emergency.
