Knights Court is a sheltered scheme for older people who want to retain their independence. The scheme is situated on the High Street in Ventnor and is handy for the shops and public transport to Newport, Shanklin, Sandown and Ryde. Ventnor Park and Botanical Gardens are nearby.

The scheme has a Resident Services Worker and is linked to an out-of-hours emergency service.

There is a large common room, where coffee mornings are held twice a week. The scheme also has a kitchen, a laundry room, a guest room and attractive gardens. The car park has space for visitors.

We welcome residents from all sections of the community.

How to get there



Directions Knights Court is on the High Street in the centre of Ventnor. There is a bus stop directly opposite the scheme.

Sheltered housing schemes

Southern Housing Group provides self-contained flats in 10 sheltered housing schemes on the Isle of Wight for more than 300 people aged 60 or over.

To apply for a place, older people will need to put their names down on the Island Homefinder register.

Each scheme has a Resident Services Worker, who provides an intensive housing management service while on duty. Out of hours, residents have access to a community alarm call system. Resident Services Workers will:

- make daily calls to all residents
- promote continued independence
- encourage residents to get involved in scheme activities
- involve other organisations that have resources to offer our residents
- signpost residents to specialist agencies.

Alongside the flats, schemes usually provide some shared facilities. For details see the front of this leaflet.
