Mayflower Court

Mayflower Court is situated in the bustling town of Haywards Heath. The town has an abundance of shops and facilities to offer and is located within walking distance of the scheme. Some of the facilities available locally include GP surgeries, Hospital, churches and a library.

A regular bus service operates to areas within the town and to outlying historical villages such as Lindfield and Cuckfield. There is a main line train station offering links to London and Brighton.

The scheme has 28 homes specifically designed for older people.

The scheme is set out over 2 floors with lift and stair access to the First floor accommodation.

There are a mixture of one and two bedroom flats throughout the scheme.

All of the properties have gas central heating and are fully double glazed.

The properties are all linked by an intercom system via a pull cord in each room, to the Scheme Manager when on duty, or to our supporting control centre out of hours.

Residents are secure in the knowledge that there is always someone available to offer support in an emergency 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

All homes and communal areas are fitted with individual smoke detectors linked to the 24-hour control centre.
Magnetic fire door closers operate throughout the communal areas of the scheme in case of fire.

Facilities

Security door entry to the main front door that can be operated from each flat.

There is a large communal lounge with adjoining kitchen where a huge variety of activities take place. These include coffee mornings, armchair exercise, bingo, darts, a lunch club, holy communion and mini bus trips to name just a few.

There is a communal laundry with washing machines and tumble dryers for the residents use.

There is a guest suite available for residents families and friends to use at a small charge.

Visiting hairdresser and chiropodist.

Location

Mayflower Court is situated in Haywards Heath and the scheme is within a short walk of the town centre allowing easy access to all of the shops and facilities.

The local bus service allows access to nearby towns and villages whilst the train station provides links to Brighton and London.

Who can apply?

Mayflower Court has been specifically designed for older people or those with disabilities, who live locally and are in need of some support. The scheme offers an opportunity for independent living in a safe, comfortable and secure environment.

Applications should be made to Mid Sussex District Council, unless you are currently a tenant of Downland Housing Association.
