Mervyn Webb Place is one of two Swindon Borough Council sheltered housing schemes in the Gorse Hill area of Swindon. It contains 31 one bedroom flats, of which 3 are in the main building and 28 are situated to the rear of the main building.

The scheme is complemented by a communal lounge, laundry and a courtyard garden to the rear of the scheme. A guest flat is also available for family and friends who want to visit a tenant living in Mervyn Webb at the cost of £8.00 per night. The scheme benefits from a communal door which all residents have a key for.

All flats have the support of a warden call system and calls for support are answered by the resident warden when onsite or on duty and by Homeline Swindon Borough Council's community alarm service outside of these hours.

All of our sheltered schemes benefit from a communal satellite dish, which gives tenants compatibility to view satellite television without the need for their own dish and a communal digital television aerial, which allows tenants to receive a digital television signal.

Mervyn Webb Place is situated on Cricklade Road and it is approximately 10 metres to the nearest Thamesdown bus route 13 and 14. Buses run from 6am to 11pm, every 10 minutes.

The nearest Doctors Surgery is approx 1/2 mile away at the Hawthorn Surgery. Shops adjacent to the scheme include a post office, banks, supermarkets, fish and chip shop, takeaways and hairdressers.

Social events at the scheme include coffee mornings, cinema evening once a month, barbecues in the summer, fish/chip supper with a sing-along.
