About the scheme

Bay Tree Farm is located in the Lea area of Preston. The scheme has 41 homes specifically designed for older people, and offers an opportunity for independent living in a safe, comfortable and secure environment.

The scheme is a mixture of one and two bedroom flats set over two floors, with stairlifts leading to the first floor accommodation. All the flats have one bedroom with separate lounge, kitchen and bathroom.

Within walking distance of the scheme there is a general store, post office and fish and chip shop. The bus stop located opposite the scheme will take you on an orbital route of Preston, including most GP surgeries, the Royal Preston Hospital, and also the city centre where there are a huge variety of shops and facilities available. There is also the main line train station at Preston where you can get trains to towns and cities further afield.

Facilities

- 41 homes
- 24 hour emergency response service via an intercom and pull cords within each property
- Gas central heating
- Communal lounge with kitchen facility where residents can meet up and have a chat. There are also regular activities held such as bingo, visiting entertainers, arts and crafts, coffee mornings and exercise classes
- Guest suite is available for residents families and friends to use for a small charge
- Gardens
- Visiting hairdresser, chiropodist and optician

Who can apply?

Bay Tree Farm is a scheme that has been designed for older people or those with disabilities.
